

Dansk SkakDommerforening

Vedtægter



1. Foreningens navn er Dansk Skakdommerforening (DSD), og dens hjemsted er til enhver tid formandens adresse. Foreningens formål er at udbrede kendskabet til FIDEs regler for skakspillet og derigennem skabe bedre dommere. Endvidere arbejder foreningen for at skabe bedre betingelser for dommere ved turneringer i Danmark, og for at skaffe danske Internationale Dommere (IA) hverv i international skak. DSD vil arbejde for hurtig og korrekt oversættelse af vedtagelser i FIDE om regler eller fortolkninger. DSD vil arbejde for en harmonisering af praksis af regler i Danmark.
2. Ledig.
3. Generalforsamlingen, der afholdes ved DM i Påsken, har den højeste myndighed i alle foreningens anliggender. Der indkaldes med mindst 7 dages varsel til generalforsamlingen pr brev, pr mail eller ved opslag på foreningens hjemmeside. Dagsorden for den årlige generalforsamling skal indeholde følgende punkter:
 1. Valg af dirigent.
 2. Formandens beretning.
 3. Kassererens beretning.
 4. Fastsættelse af kontingent.
 5. Indkomne forslag. Disse skal være formanden i hænde senest den 1.marts. Forslag der indebærer vedtægtsændringer skal udsendes til medlemmerne senest 14 dage før Påske.
 6. Valg af bestyrelse. Formanden og kassereren vælges særskilt. I lige år er formanden og i ulige år kassereren på valg. Øvrige bestyrelsesmedlemmer vælges for 2 år ad gangen, generalforsamlingen fastsætter antallet af bestyrelsesmedlemmer.
 7. Valg af revisor.
 8. Eventuelt.Afgørelser træffes ved almindelig stemmeflerhed, undtaget vedtægtsændringer som nævnt i paragraf 5.
4. Bestyrelsen består af en formand, en kasserer og et, to eller tre menige medlemmer. Bestyrelsen optræder på foreningens vegne og kan under ansvar over for generalforsamlingen disponere til foreningens bedste og formålets fremme. Afgørelser træffes ved almindelig stemmeflerhed, ved lige stemmetal er formandens stemme afgørende.
5. Ændringer i foreningens love kan kun ske på den årlige generalforsamling, og kun når mindst 2/3 af de mødte i afstemningen deltagende medlemmer stemmer for forslaget. Bestemmelse om foreningens ophævelse kan kun gyldigt vedtages, hvis mindst 3/4 af samtlige foreningens medlemmer stemmer herfor, eller hvis 2/3 af de tilstedeværende på en generalforsamling fulgt af almindelig stemmeflerhed i en skriftlig afstemning blandt alle foreningens medlemmer stemmer herfor. Skulle foreningen ophøre med at eksistere, tilfalder dens eventuelle formue Dansk Skak Unions Støtteforening.

Organisation of Danish Chess Arbiters

Statutes



1. The name of the organisation is "The organisation of Danish Chess Arbiters" and its residence is at any time the home address of the president. The organisation aims at improving the knowledge of the FIDE official laws of chess thereby producing better arbiters. Furthermore the organisation endeavours to provide better conditions for arbiters at tournaments in Denmark and to provide Danish International Arbiters assignments at international chess events. The organisation will work for quick and correct translations of decisions in FIDE concerning rules or interpretations. The organisation will work for uniform interpretation of rules in Denmark.
2. Not used
3. The general assembly held annually during the Danish championships at Easter time has the highest authority in all matters of the organisation. The general assembly must be called with 7 days notice by letter, by mail or by notice on the home page of the organization. The agenda of the annual general assembly must contain the following items:
 1. Election of a chairman of the assembly
 2. Annual report of the president
 3. Annual report of the treasurer
 4. Adjustment of the annual membership fee
 5. Received motions. These must be received by the president no later than the 1st of March. Motions implying a change of statutes must be sent to all members of the organisation 14 days before Easter.
 6. The election of the executive board. The president and the treasurer are elected individually. In even years the president and in odd years the treasurer is elected. The rank-and-file members are elected for 2 years; the number of rank-and-file members is decided by the general assembly.
 7. Election of an accountant
 8. SundryDecisions are made by simple majority of votes, except for the change of statutes as mentioned in statute number 5.
4. The executive board consists of a president, a treasurer and one, two or three rank-and-file members. The executive board represents the organisation and can - responsible to the general assembly - act for and in accordance with the aim of the organisation. Decisions are made by simple majority of votes. In case of equality the vote of the president is decisive.
5. Changes of statutes can only take place at the annual general assembly and only when at least 2/3 of the membership present vote in favour of the change. The dissolution of the organisation requires a majority of at least 3/4 of the total membership, or a majority of at least 2/3 of the membership present at the general assembly followed by a simple majority in a written ballot among the total membership of the organisation. If the organisation dissolves, its net assets will be donated to "Dansk Skak Unions Støtteforening" ("The Organisation in support of the Danish Chess Federation").
